1st instalment when you register; 2nd on 30 October 2014; 3rd on 31 December 2014.

Price for Choral conducting: €735

- you can pay in 3 instalments at no extra charge; 1^{st} instalment of €275 when you register; 2^{nd} et 3^{rd} instalments of €230 on 30 October 2014 and 31 December 2014.
- a supplement of €100 for course participants conducting at the concert will be added to one of these instalments.

Full-board accomodation available on site

Should the course participant cancel one month or less before the masterclass, the course organisers will retain their first instalment.

Should the organisers cancel the masterclass, all of the first instalment will be reimbursed.

Teaching

The first two days (19-20/08) will be spent on theoretical study of the music.

On the third day (21/08) all course participants will undertake practical work with the professional choir. At the end of the day, 8 students will be chosen to conduct the final concert.

These 8 students will spend the last two days (22-23/08) working with the professional choir.

End of course concert on Saturday 23 August 2014 at 9pm in the Sala Accademica in Rome.

The course choir will be made up of 6 Italian and 6 French professional singers from the Choeur Britten.

We welcome outside listeners to all 4 masterclasses. If you would like to attend for the whole week, you must sign up by 10 June 2014. If you would like to attend for just one day, you can sign up on site, in the day itself, subject to availability.
